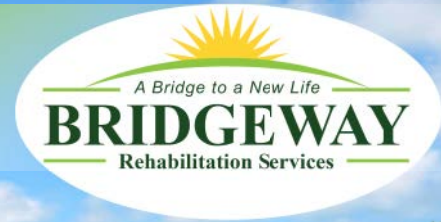

New multi-use building in Union Township



## Bridgeway Begins Renovations on Multi-Use Building in Union County

Union, NJ – After serving Union County for more than 50 years, Bridgeway is excited to announce the purchase and renovation of a new multi-use facility in Union Township. Bridgeway has purchased the property at 373 Clermont Terrace, and renovations begin in early October 2020.

Over the years, Bridgeway Rehabilitation Services has become well-known as a leader for mental health services in central and northern New Jersey. Bridgeway has grown from one small facility at 615 North Broad Street, Elizabeth, which today houses the executive and administration teams, to more than a dozen direct service facilities across our service region.

The purchase of the Clermont Terrace building, a 25,000-square foot former commercial school building, will enable Bridgeway to relocate all administrative staff and offices to the Union Township property. Bridgeway's facility at Clermont Terrace will be a multi-use building housing six direct care programs, including three PACT teams (Programs of Assertive Community Treatment), Supportive Housing, Intensive Supportive Housing, and Career Services. "This building was worth waiting for," says Cory Storch, President & CEO of Bridgeway, "After an exhaustive search that took years, Bridgeway will now be able to serve many more people who are in need of intensive mental health services while ending our reliance on leased space, and literally building the future of mental health services in our region. Consolidating our Union County presence is a win-win opportunity!"

On September 9th, Bridgeway hosted a socially-distant pre-renovation "opening" of 373 Clermont Terrace to offer stakeholders the opportunity to tour the building prior to the construction company taking over the site. Bridgeway was honored to host Senator Cryan, who said "Cory and the folks at Bridgeway do great things... thank you for coming, thank you for the investment, and we look forward to a long partnership!"
